Bioboard is **Visionchart's** 100% environmentally friendly backing board which is used in all our **Vision** Communicate range of whiteboards, cork and noticeboards. **Bioboard** is made from agriculturally derived biomass which can be made from sugar cane, rice corn or wheat stalks as well as poplar plantation trees. These qualities afford **Bioboard** with a firm yet pinnable density which still maintains its shape throughout the manufacturing process.

The lack of dangerous glues or other processes chemicals means that there are minimal dangerous emission during recycling and ensures a maximum level of recyclability for these boards. This is a dramatic contrast to other communication boards offered by competitors. **Bioboard** Communication Boards do not include any of the harmful and non-recyclable materials such as hard plastics, corflute or dangerous glues present in other entry level communication boards. Even with **Bioboard's** environmentally friendly focus, it still manages to be at worst competitively priced to its competitors in some cases being the cheaper alternative.

No toxic glues or carcinogenic formaldehyde are used in the preparation or manufacturing of **Bioboard**. **Bioboard** is made through heat and compression to create density in the board with minimal binding agents. **Bioboard** is 100% biodegradable and recyclable, and it uses biomass material which would have otherwise been burnt in the past – further contributing to CO2 emissions and other greenhouse gasses.

The recyclability and sustainability of **Bioboard** Communication Boards doesn't end with the backing board, but extends towards every component.

The frame used is made from recycled aluminium which can then be recycled again as in much of the same way as the magnetic surface and corner fixing which are all recyclable.

This environmentally friendly focus does not end with our **Bioboard** Communication Boards, but extends towards our other products.

So think hard next time you consider an inexpensive and poorly performing whiteboard, about what else you could be saving...
